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PSA 17-18

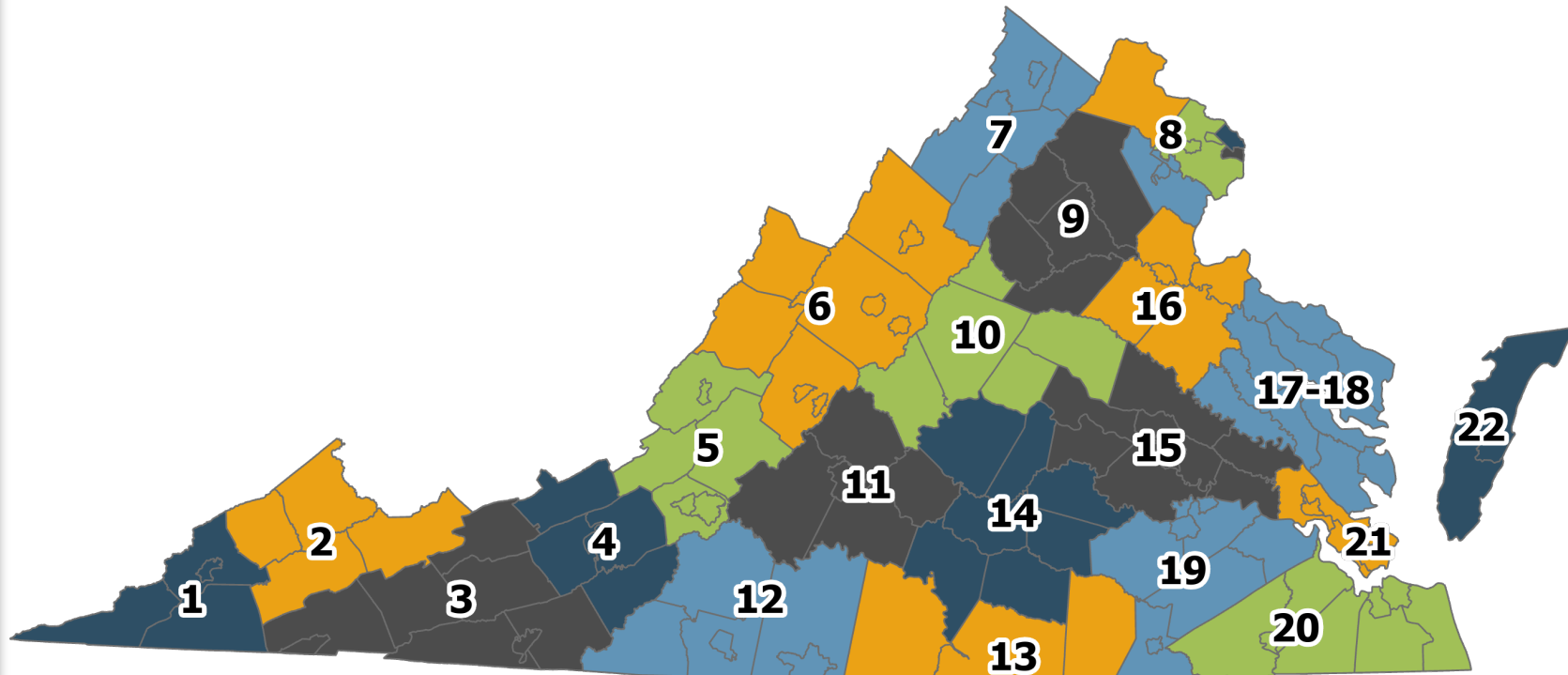


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Planning and Service Area 17-18 (PSA) includes **Essex County, Gloucester County, King and Queen County, King William County, Lancaster County, Mathews County, Middlesex County, Northumberland County, Richmond County, and Westmoreland County.**

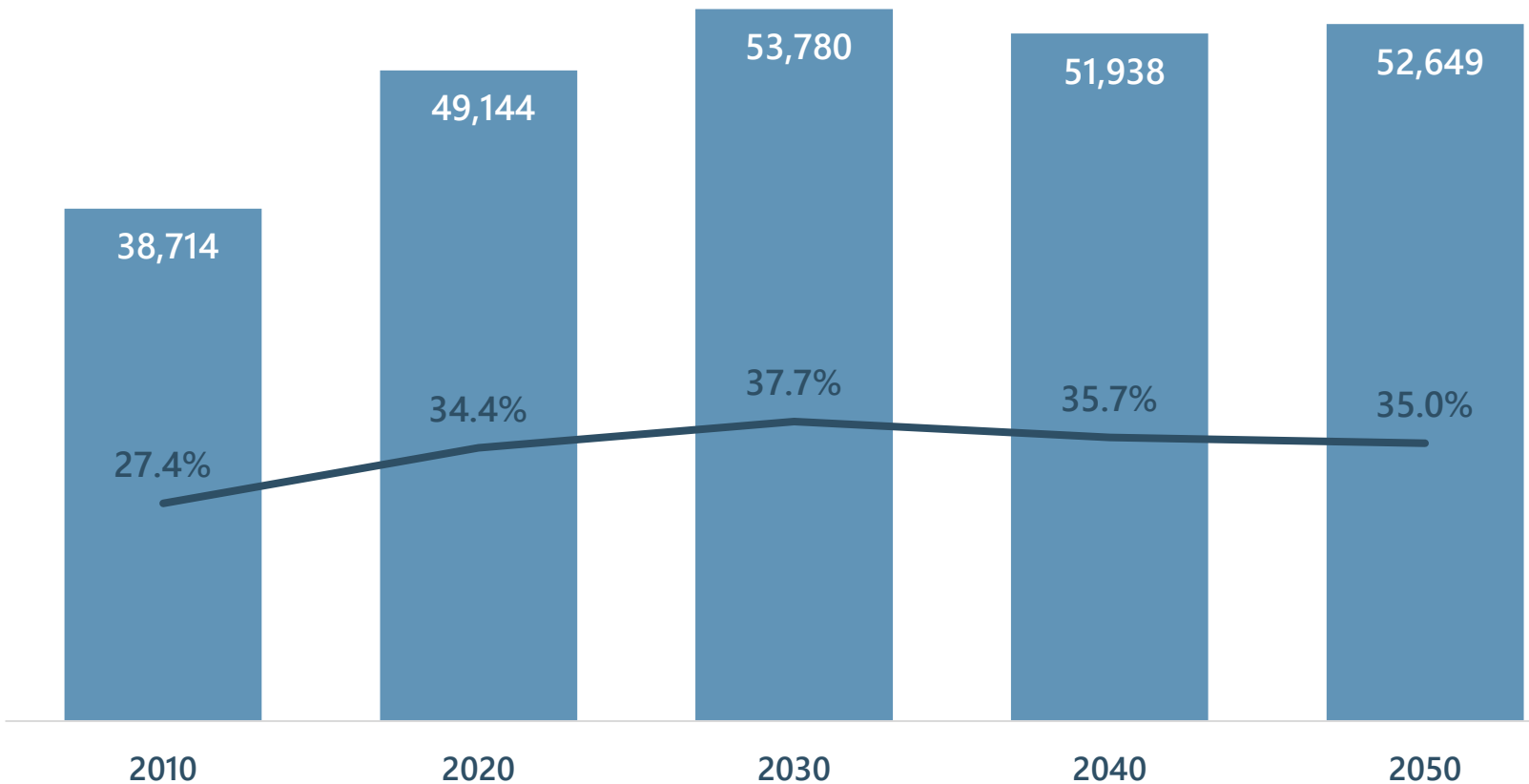
As of 2020, there were **47,933 Virginians aged 60+**, accounting for **33.5% of the total population** in PSA 17-18.¹

POPULATION PROJECTIONS



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By 2030, Virginians aged 60+ will comprise **37.7%** of the total population in PSA 17-18.²

The 60+ population in Virginia PSA 17-18 is **expected to stabilize** but the **rate of growth is projected to decline** each successive decade until 2050.²



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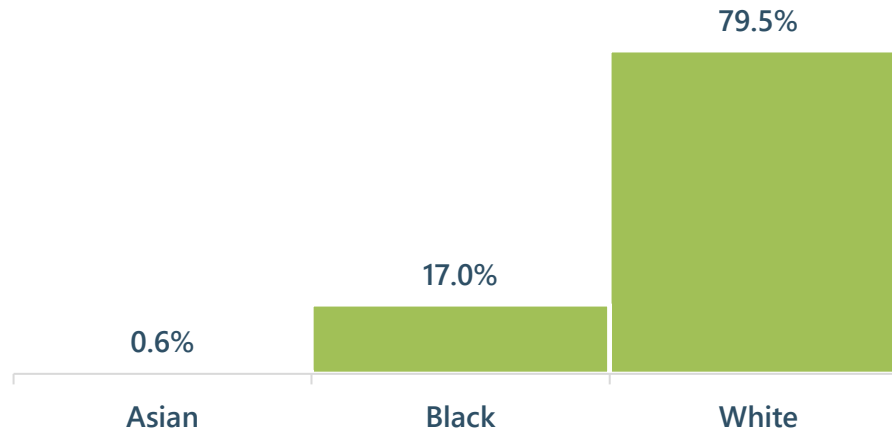
GENDER, RACE, & HISPANIC ORIGIN

53% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 were **women** and **47% men**.¹

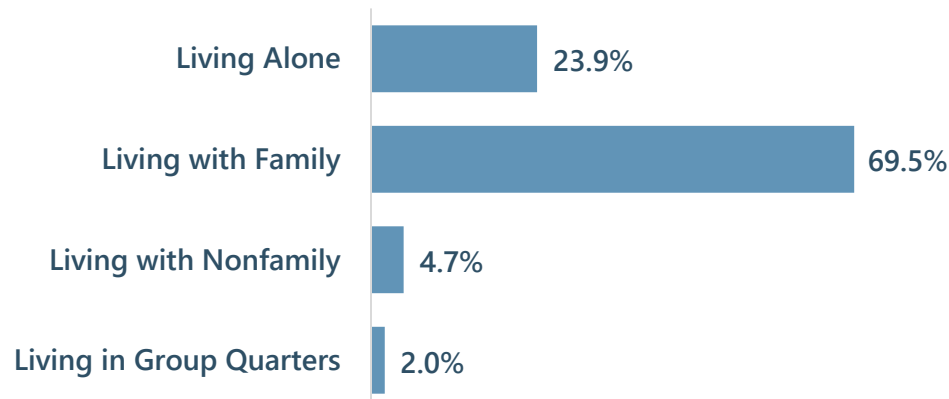
Among 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18, **1.2%** were **Hispanic**.¹

Other non-Hispanic racial groups consisted of less than 2%.¹

MARITAL STATUS & LIVING ARRANGEMENT



60+ Adults by Living Arrangement



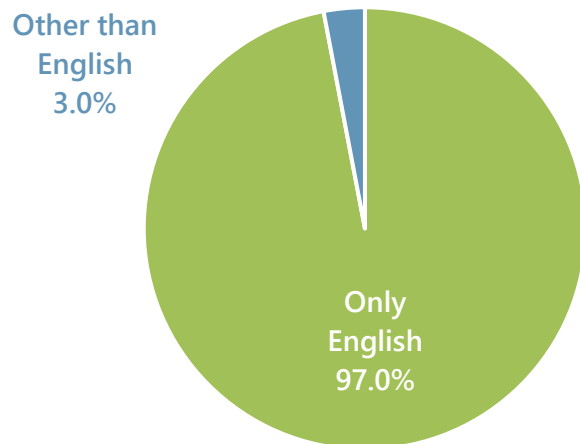
23.9% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 **lived alone**.³

60.5% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 were married or partnered, followed by **19.2%** widowed, **12.5%** divorced, **5.1%** never married/single, and **2.7%** separated.³

LANGUAGE SPOKEN AT HOME



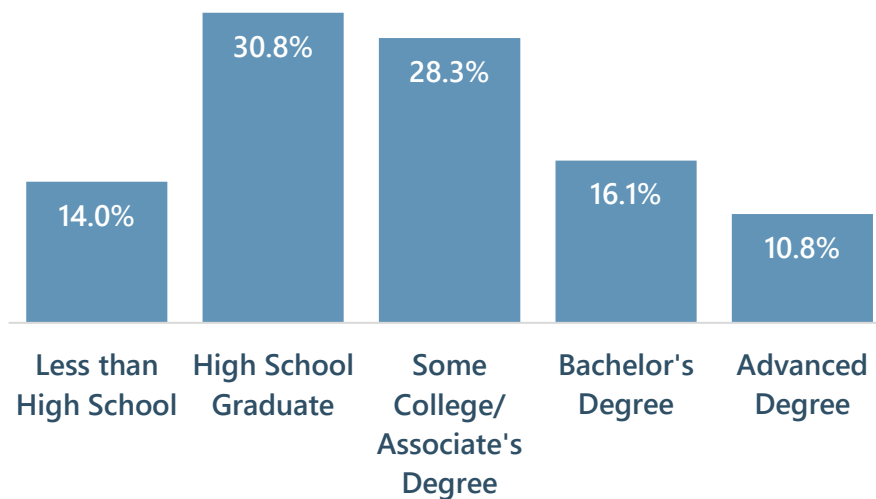
60+ Adults by Language Spoken Most at Home



2.7% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 were foreign-born immigrants.³

Among 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18, **3%** said they mostly **spoke other languages** than English at home.³

EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT



14% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 had less than a high school education.³

10.8% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-18 had graduate or professional degrees.³

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POVERTY & ECONOMIC STATUS



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7.8% of 60+ Virginians in
PSA 17-18 were **in
poverty**.³



6.9% of households in PSA 17-
18 with 60+ older adults
**received food stamps or
SNAP**.⁴

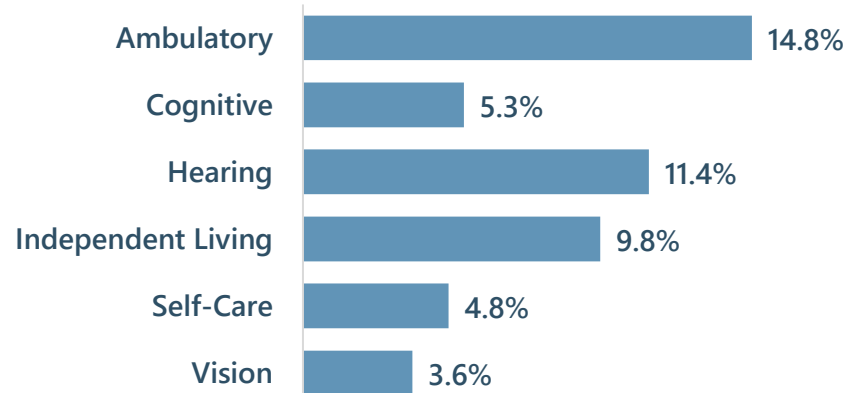


11.9% of 60+ householders in

DISABILITY & HEALTH



60+ Adults by Disability Type



26.1% of 60+ Virginians in PSA 17-
18 had a **disability** and **11.7%** had
two or more types of disabilities.³

Among those with a disability in
PSA 17-18, **0.9%** had **no health
insurance coverage**.³
